4. To report the collaboration with WHEEBOX, an Online Talent Assessment Company for Mapping the Employability Skills of the Products of Higher Education and Building 'India Skill Report 2019'

Note: A request was received from WHEEBOX in 2015 seeking AIU Collaboration in Mapping the Employability Skills of Higher Education Products and Building "India Skill Report". The Research Division took up the task after MoU was signed by AIU with WHEEBOX. Since 2015 this has been a regular activity of the Research Division. All supports are provided by Research Division to Wheebox in mapping the Skill Sets of the final year students of the member Universities of AIU. Certificate of Endorsement bearing AIU, WHEEBOX and FICCI logos are awarded to the candidates appearing in this exercise and the India Skills Reports are published on year to year basis. In the current year the process is going on the "India Skills Report-2019 shall be released during November 2018. In the whole exercise Research Division plays a major role as an Academic Partner.

The Research Division collaborated and provided necessary support in successfully organizing the Conference. No Financial Grant was given. Report was not received from Symbiosis.

6. To report the successful organization of a National Conference on 'Rejuvenation of Under Graduate Education in India' in collaboration with Centre for Educational and Social Studies (CESS) National Institute of Advanced Studies at Indian Institute of Sciences Campus, Bengaluru.

Note: A request was received from Centre for Educational and Social Studies (CESS), National Institute of Advanced Studies, Bengaluru seeking AIU Collaboration for organizing the above Conference. The event was organized during August 10-11, 2018 at Indian Institute of Sciences Campus. Research Division extended necessary supports as Academic/Knowledge Partner in organizing the event. No Financial Grant was given. Around 90 papers were presented in the conference. Efforts are being made to bring out the proceedings of the conference with around 40/45 selected good papers. CESS has sought financial help from AIU to bring out the Proceedings. They have been informed that Research Division shall assist in short listing, compiling, editing and all other academic support in bringing out the proceedings which may be a joint Publication of AIU and CESS without any Financial Support.

7. To report the Rescheduled dates of the Roundtable of Vice Chancellors of Open and Distance Education Universities

The Research Division provided necessary academic support and a Financial support of Rs. 3.00 lakhs was sanctioned. Roundtable is scheduled to be held now on November 11-12, 2018.

8. To report the Progress of the Research Compendium of the Research Projects presented in Anveshan: National Research Convention

[Note: Anveshan: the National Student Research Convention was organized at Chitkara University, Punjab in which 75 Research Projects selected at

9. To report the Progress of Database Project on Financing of Universities in India

[Note: In the process of reviving the preparation of Database, a regular activity of the Research Division, which was discontinued for some period, a project on the Data base on Financing of Universities was initiated in 2016. After reminders and continuous pursuance data was received from 120 Institutions. Further it was decided to publish it in data base pamphlet/booklet format. Data entry of maximum institution has been complete. The draft pamphlet with an introduction on the current and evolving procedure of Financing of Universities along-with a brief status analysis is in progress.]

10. To report the completion of the Research Study on Social Exclusion and Inclusive Policies in Higher Education: A Study on Centers of Social Exclusion and Inclusive Policies in Indian Universities

[Note: A study on the aforementioned title was taken up in which questionnaires were sent to all the 35 centers (CSSEIP) of Indian universities. In total 15 centers responded out of which two centers had provided incomplete data. The data provided by other 13 Centres were analysed. And some secondary source of data such as annual reports, policy documents, mission and objectives of the centres etc. also analysed. The draft report is ready.]

11. To consider the proposal for taking a Research Project on Impact of Refresher Programmes on developing Research and Teaching Skills: A study of UGC Human Resource Development Centres (HRDC) in Indian Universities.

[Note: A study on the aforementioned title was initiated in 2015. Due to shortage of manpower the project couldn't be taken up. Following the recruitment of a Senior Research Assistant, the proposal for starting the project is being proposed.]

[Note: All the Five events are the regular activities of the Research Division. As per MHRD Guidelines, one event is to be held in one of the North Eastern States. Considering the high demand for workshops on Research Methodology in Social Sciences, it was decided that two Workshops i.e. in Research Methodology will be organized in the current Financial Year (FY). One each of the remaining four events will be held in the Financial Year 2018-19. Notifications inviting proposals for collaboration from member universities were given in *University News* and in AIU Website. In view of the time constraints, the received proposals were shortlisted and programmes were allocated which may be ratified by the Committee.]

Observation: Since the Programmes have already been started, it should have been mentioned as reporting Item. The Secretary General explained that these programmes are of the current year. Because of the Session change and taking over as New President in the month of July the calendar of events is being submitted to Research Committee Meeting for approval. The proposal for these events were invited by notifying in University News and Uploading in Website. The calendar was prepared in anticipation of the approval of the Research Committee Meeting.

13. To consider the proposal for organizing the Roundtable of Vice Chancellors of Central Universities at Tezpur University, Assam during December 28-29, 2018.

[Note: It was resolved in the Research Committee Meeting in 2015-16 to organize Ten Roundtables of Vice Chancellors of Universities in various disciplines. Five Roundtables such as Sanskrit, State Universities, Private Universities, Engineering & Technology and Health Sciences were already held earlier. The Roundtable of Vice Chancellors of Central Universities will be the sixth in Series. The event is scheduled during December 28-29, 2018.

- To consider enhancement of the Financial support to member Universities those organize AIU Programmes in Collaboration
 - Note: Approval for Financial Support amount for the host universities of AIU programmes was obtained in 2016 as per following:
 - a) IT & Management Workshop: Rs: 3.00 lakhs (3 days duration, for 45-55 Participants)
 - b) Research Methodology Workshop: Rs 4.00 lakhs (7 days duration for 50-60 Partcipants:
 - c) Seminar: Rs 3.00 lakhs (Two days duration for 45-55 Participants)
 - d) Roundtables: Rs 4.00 lakhs (Two days duration)
 - e) Anveshan: Research Conventions: Rs 3.50 lakhs for Zonal and Rs. 5.00 Lakhs for National)

Note: In some of the events due to increase in the number of participants, the host universities are insisting for enhancing the financial support. In view of this proposal for enhancing the amount of Financial support was proposed)

- Resolution: Research Committee resolved that the financial support need not be enhanced. Instead the Registration fees as prescribed by AIU be allowed to be retained fully by the host universities
